RESOLUTION NO. 2012 - 902

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE INTENT TO SELL PERSONAL PROPERTY NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE BY INTERNET AUCTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15(D) authorizes the legislative authority of a municipal corporation to sell personal property, including motor vehicles acquired for the use of municipal offices and departments, and road machinery, equipment, tools, or supplies, which is not needed for public use, or is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired, by internet auction; and,

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of LaGrange, Ohio desires to sell unneeded, obsolete or unfit personal property owned or hereafter acquired by the Village of LaGrange by internet auction from time to time throughout the calendar year 2012.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of LaGrange, Ohio, a majority of members elected or appointed thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The Village Administrator shall be and is hereby authorized to place for auction and to sell to the highest bidder such unneeded, obsolete or unfit personal property, as may be authorized by resolution of Council from time to time, by internet auction.

Section 2: Such auction shall be conducted by a representative pursuant to contact with the Village. The terms of sale will require receipt of payment in full prior to tender or delivery of such personal property.

Section 3: Such resolution of Council may establish a minimum price that will be accepted for each such item and may provide for further terms and conditions, including but not limited to the website and identity of the servicer of the auction, requirements for pickup and delivery, method of payment and sales tax. Any such terms or conditions shall be contained in the advertisement for internet auction and shall be made available to any person upon request.

Section 4: Internet actions shall remain open for bidding for period of not less than ten (10) consecutive days, including Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays.

Section 5: The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to cause the publication of a notice containing a summary of the information contained therein not less than two (2) times in a newspaper in general circulation in the Village of LaGrange. The second such publication shall be made not less than ten (10), nor more than twenty (20) days after the date of the first publication. The Fiscal Officer is further authorized and directed to cause a copy of the notice so published to be posted in a conspicuous place in the Village municipal building and, continually throughout the calendar year 2012, and on the LaGrange Village website.

Section 6: Resolution No. 2012 - 773 is hereby repealed.

Section 7: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the
